Event Overview:

Sunday, July 9th | Centennial Plaza, Sandy Oregon

The Sandy Area Chamber of Commerce is excited to announce the second annual Chili Cook Off and Kid's Bake Off at Music Fair and Feast. This event is guaranteed to draw in a crowd of people who want to cook, bake sample and vote. We will begin the Chili Cook Off portion at 1pm. This category is for ages 18+. **The chili will be judged in three categories: People's choice aka the Best Chili in Sandy (\$200 Prize), Judges Choice (\$100 Prize), and Chef's choice (\$50 Prize). There is a \$25 participation fee.**

Guidelines for participating:

- Participants are required to supply 3 gallons of each chili entry, along with a listing of main ingredients such as pork, beef, or vegetarian
- Participants must provide a table and extension cord.
- Participants must have people present to serve samples of the chili.
- Participants are welcome bring a table top business sign and can choose to bring promotional items to distribute

Benefits of Participation:

Participants will receive prominent recognition in a variety of forms, including:

- **Online** - Your Business name and/or logo will be utilized in the Chili Cook-Off portion of our website.

- **Social Media** – Promotion of the event through Sandy Area Chamber of Commerce Facebook page, Sandy Music Fair & Feast Facebook page, and Sandy Area Chamber of Commerce instagram.
- **Email EBlasts** – Your business name and/or logo will be included in information sent on email blasts through Sand Area Chamber of Commerce.
- **Press Releases** – Your business may be mentioned in press releases sent out to all appropriate media outlets before and after the event. *Must be received by July 30th*
- **Chili Cook-Off Advertising:** Any advertisement sent out the week before the event.

Frequently Asked Questions:

1. Who can drink beer at the Chili Cook-Off / Music Fair and Feast?

Those that are 21+ may purchase beer from the beer garden with a wristband. Proper ID must be shown in order to receive a wristband.

2. Can I sell items at my table?

No, but you may give away any promotional items you'd like. The more things you give away, the better chance you'll have at winning the People's Choice category!

3. Who will be judging my chili?

Our judges choice award will be determined by our head judges from our sponsors at Clackamas County Bank. People's choice award will be decided from a popular vote from the crowd. And chef's choice will be voted on by the fellow chili chefs.

4. What if it rains?

The event is rain or shine. We recommend bringing a tent for this reason.

5. Do I need to be present to win?

Yes. Winners will be announced by 2pm.

6. What does the Sandy Area Chamber of Commerce provide?

The SACC provides a sign for your table, tablecloth, napkins, utensils and sample cups.

7. Are pets allowed at the event?

Well behaved dogs on a leash are welcome!

By signing this agreement, I, on behalf of my myself / business, agree to the following stipulations:

- All entries must be made from scratch. Chili must arrive to the competition heated and ready to be served in either a crock-pot or hot plate. There will be time to continue heating before judging begins.
- Each chili must be a minimum of three gallons. There is no maximum quantity a competitor may prepare.
- Competitors must be set up by 11:30 am and torn down by 2:30 pm. No vehicles will be allowed in the competition area.
- All entrants participate at their own risk. The decisions of the judges are final. Event organizers reserve the right to change or modify these rules at any time. Any changes will be communicated to all entrants. Event organizers also reserve the right to disqualify any competitor for violation of these rules.
- Entry payment may be made in form of cash, check or card by going into the chamber office. You can also go online to www.sandyoregonchamber.org and click on the Chili Cook Off link to pay online through paypal.
